<p>Records of 11 offspring of whom John is the youngest (and second called John)</p> <p>Westerkirk is a few miles southwest of Tima Water, near Meggat water. Parents unknown, but from names of children it is most likely that Andrew's father's name was Walter (eldest son). It is noted that the births of the first few children are given at Glenkerry (near Gair) suggesting that Andrew's generation was the first at Gair and therefore he may not have been born there. There is a marriage record for a Walter Laidlaw and Margaret Grieve at westerkirk which is a possibility but no conclusive evidence has been found.</p>

<p>Will of John Glendinning of Effgill at Dumfries 1 May 1812 signed by Archibald Glendinning, Walter Laidlaw and Thomas Goldie. John had no dependants and left his estate to nieces and nephews including Andrew Laidlaw in Gair. This implies Agnes was John's sister and therefore Archibald Glendinning's daughter and James Glendinning's granddaughter.</p>
