Children: Agnes, Elizabeth, Walter, James and Andrew all appear with Andrew and Susannah in 1841 Census. LDS IGI has an entry for Isabella Laidlaw in 1830. This may in fact be Elzabeth. The Census entry is not clear. It begins with a clear "E" but ends with what looks like " bella". The informant for Andrew's death is shown as Peter Hall son in law and there is a LDS IGI record for the marriage of Peter Hall and Elizabeth Laidlaw backed up by an entry in the 1881 census. This census also shows Harriet Laidlaw age 20, Farm servant, on the same census page as Andrew and Susannah but in a different house. A search for Harriet in SRO records came up with a Harriet Laidlaw who died in 1890 aged 69 giving approximate birth date of 1822. Parents given as Andrew Laidlaw, shepherd, and Susan Laidlaw (m/s Burnet). The maiden surname could be an error on the part of the informant since Andrew's

<p>mother's maiden name was Burnet.</p> <p>LDS IGI has a record of Margaret Laidlaw daughter of Chusan (sic) and Andrew Laidlaw 5 September 1823 at Channelkirk.</p> <p>LDS Pedigree files also suggests Nancy and Davina. I cannot find these in the SRO records either birth or census, However it may be significant that the 1881 census records for son Andrew and his wife Charlotte show a daughter called Davina. There is an 1841 census record for Ann Laidlaw , Dressmaker, living at Eyemouth and aged 20 giving birth date around 1821 who could be Nancy but there is no definite connection to Andrew and Susan and there are other possibilities.</p> <p>The naming conventions seem to have been followed in respect of oldest son John, oldest daughter Harriet and second daughter Margaret, but no record has been found of a Francis. There is five year gap between Margaret and Agnes.</p> <p>1851 census shows granddaughter Harriet Turnbull 12, suspect this is Harriet Laidlaw, daughter of Harriet as age is correct. This census also shows grandson James Taylor aged 9, connection has not been traced.</p> <p>1861 census shows granddaughter Margaret aged 8. It is most likely this is a daughter of John Laidlaw and Christina Ewart. Margaret would have been too young to appear on the 1851 census with the rest of this family.</p>
